

**2006 STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ORDINANCE FOR FLOODPLAIN
MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS**

TOWNSHIP OF BAINBRIDGE

BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Bainbridge Township located in Berrien County, under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

BAINBRIDGE TOWNSHIP HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of Bainbridge Township is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Bainbridge Township under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. Bainbridge Township assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act through out its corporate limits.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within Bainbridge Township.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled the Berrien County Flood Insurance Study and dated April 17, 2006, and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26021C0037C*, 0040C, 0041C*, 0042C, 0045C*, 0061C, 0063C*, 0130C, 0135C, and 0155C (*not printed because flood prone areas not identified), dated 4/17/06, are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code.

Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.

This ordinance duly adopted on July 10, 2006, at a regular meeting of the Bainbridge Township Board and will become effective on August 9, 2006.

A motion that said State Construction Code Ordinance be enacted was made by John Yetzke and supported by Jerry Jollay at a regular meeting of the Bainbridge Township Board on the 10th day of July, 2006.
